

US Bank robbed; Suspect still at large

Police received a call at about 9:46 am this morning that US Bank on 101 W. Hill Ave had been robbed, Gallup Police Department Sgt. Rosanne Morrisette said.

Initial reports indicate that the suspect is a tall, thin white male in his 40s and who stands about 5'11" to 6'1." He was wearing a dark in color hoody pulled up around his face, and blue jeans.

Details are pending, but Morrisette said the man walked into the bank, showed the teller a handgun and made off with an undisclosed amount of cash. He took off out of the bank on foot, and was last seen running southbound on 1st Street. Video stillshots of the bank robbery are pending, and will be posted on this site as they become available. Police are asking for the public's help to catch this suspect.
