

A waterline break that occurred near the corner of Aztec and Ciniza was repaired within a matter of hours Jan. 24. The break occurred around 8 am. Utility crews closed off the intersection to put a stop to the gushing water by repairing the line.

According to an email from Dennis Romero, P.E., of Gallup Utilities, forwarded to the *Sun* by City Manager Maryann Ustick, the line was repaired and placed back into service shortly before 1 pm.

Romero said the "break was in a 14-inch ductile iron line."

He also said that a new line was installed in the area about 2010.

"This break was a 4-inch blowout in the older section of the line," he said. "A clamp/patch was installed to repair the leak."

Ustick said that no homes in the area sustained damages.
