A family was riding their bikes in the China Loop area about 7:30 pm when they reported hearing shots being fired.

Terry Wilson told deputies for the McKinley County Sheriff's Office that they could hear the bullets "whizzing over their heads."

Deputies were able to track the shots to a house about three-fourths of a mile away where they met the homeowner who said he was shooting at some dogs who strayed onto his property.

Since the land where the shootings took place was on the Navajo Reservation, the matter was turned over to the Navajo Police Department.
