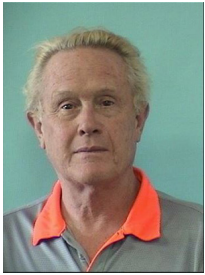


Alleged child sex abuser absconds from pre-trial release

FBI asking for public's help locating man

ALBUQUERQUE – A man charged federally with aggravated sexual abuse is being sought for allegedly absconding from pre-trial release in Albuquerque.

Jan Jay Moolenijzer's last known location was Tucson, Ariz.

The FBI arrested Moolenijzer in Albuquerque on Sept. 8, 2018, after a federal criminal complaint was filed. He was indicted on four counts of aggravated sexual abuse on March 27.

Moolenijzer, 68, was placed on strict pre-trial conditions of release on Sept. 18. He allegedly left an Albuquerque halfway house without permission on Aug. 5.

A federal warrant has been issued for Moolenijzer's arrest.

Moolenijzer was born in California, but has lived in New Mexico, Mexico, Costa Rica, and Boliva.
