8:30 am-11 am and 1 pm-4 pm Mon.-Fri. @ College Clinic (2111 College Dr.). For COVID-19 vaccine for children ages 5-11. A patient guardian will be required to remain with the patient and wait 15 minutes for observation immediately after vaccine is given.

All patients and visitors entering the hospital or clinics with a cloth mask, will be provided a procedure/surgical mask to wear while on the property of RMCHCS.

RMCHCS VISITATION GUIDELINES

Due to the recent surge in virus cases, Rehoboth McKinley Christian Health Care Services has reinstated its no visitors policy.

One family member or support person who has passed the coronavirus screening may:

Accompany a pregnant woman into the Birthing Center and stay with her during labor, delivery, and postpartum. No additional visitors will be allowed at this time.

Stay with a pediatric patient at all times until the patient is discharged from the hospital.

Accompany a patient requiring a personal care attendant at admissions. Once that person
